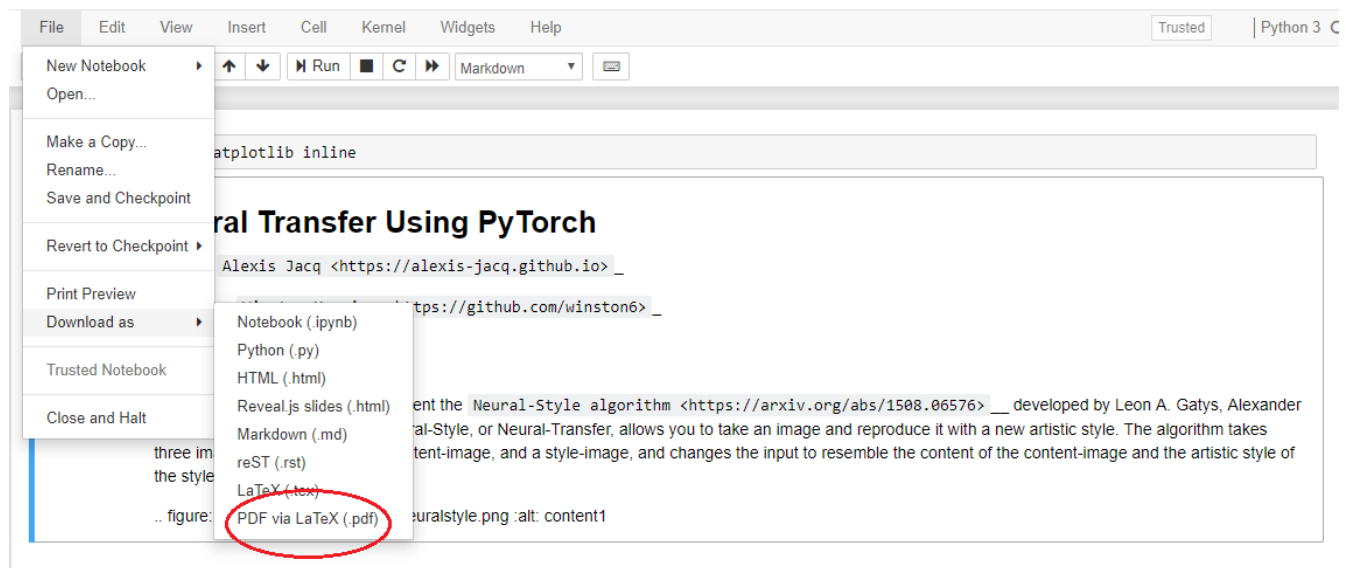
1 Exporting Notebook as PDF

You can export a notebook (.ipynb) in several formats (.html, .pdf, .tex, etc). PDF conversion can be done mainly in two ways.

1.1 Option 1. Using Jupyter Notebook

Open the notebook using Jupyter. Then at the top left corner choose:

File → Download as → PDF via LaTeX (.pdf)



1.2 Option 2. From the Command Line

The basic command structure is:

```
$ jupyter nbconvert my_notebook.ipynb --to pdf
```

Exporting to PDF requires nbconvert, Pandoc and TeX (specifically, XeLaTeX). Details on installation can be found here: <https://nbconvert.readthedocs.io/en/latest/install.html>

2 Submitting PDF on Gradescope

Go to Gradescope, click on the relevant assignment and upload the exported PDF of your notebook. Gradescope will then open a tiled view of all pages in the document. Select a question on the left hand side and the corresponding pages in your PDF.

To review and/or resubmit click on the relevant assignment to view your submission. In the bottom right hand corner of your browser, you should see a "resubmit" button.
